## Fast Midlands

Lincolnshire County Council <u>ruled</u> that a future planning permission application at IGas Energy PLC Glentworth site would not require an environmental impact assessment. IGas have <u>applied</u> for planning permission for battery storage facilities at their Welton Gathering Centre.

Egdon Resources PLC <u>announced</u> that they have submitted an appeal against the refusal by Lincolnshire County Council to extend planning permission for the North Kelsey site.

Union Jack Oil PLC <u>published</u> an update on the reduction of capital exercise that they are pursuing.

Rathlin Energy (UK) Ltd <u>published</u> (entry on 16 August 2022) their Directors' report and financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2021.

Angus Energy PLC <u>published</u> an update on the commissioning at Saltfleetby. Angus <u>announced</u> that they had made its first nominations for gas export and sale to Shell via National Grid.

## South East
