## East Midlands

Egdon Resources plc released an <u>update</u> on the Wressle well, mentioning that limited volumes of water have been observed. Egdon Resources <u>announced</u> that the North Sea Transition Authority condition over their acquisition by Pertichor had been satisfied.

Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that the Environmental Agency has given formal consent of oil and gas production at an expanded West Newton-A site.

## South Fast

Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that Protect Dunsfold would be applying to the Court of appeal to overturn the judge's ruling allowing work to proceed at Dunsfold.

Corfe Energy Ltd has changed its name to Tetra Energy UK Onshore Ltd.

Star Energy Group plc (formerly IGas) <u>announced</u> the acquisition of a geothermal development company in Croatia.
