East Midlands

Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that East Riding of Yorkshire Council have confirmed that Rathlin Energy has breached planning permission at West Newton-A. Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that East Yorkshire planners have ruled that revised proposals from Rathlin Energy for West Newton-A do not require an environmental impact assessment.

Angus Energy PLC released an <u>update</u> on the schedule for Saltfleetby. Angus Energy have <u>applied</u> to Lincolnshire Council for planning permission to change the layout of the Saltfleetby gas site.

Lincoln County Councillors have <u>explained</u> why they rejected Egdon Resources U.K. Ltd application to drill at Biscathorpe. Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that Egdon Resources have submitted a planning application for North Kelsey. Egdon Resources <u>published</u> a pre AGM Financial and Operational Update.

Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) plc published an Annual General Meeting statement.

Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that Lincolnshire Council planners refused permission for IGas Energy plc to abandon well A31 at Welton-A.

South East

Angus Energy PLC released an <u>update</u> on the reinterpretation of the Lidsey field. Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that the Environment Agency is seeking public comments on the proposal for Angus Energy to dispose of waste water at Brockham.

UK Oil & Gas plc (UKOG) <u>announced</u> that they had signed an agreement with Ceraphi Energy to develop a geothermal energy hub at Horse Hill. UKOG released a <u>statement</u> on Directors Share Purchase and Share Options.
