Angus Energy plc <u>reported</u> on the progress of the Saltfleetby sidetrack. Angus <u>announced</u> that they had closed the placing and subscription of Ordinary Shares.

Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) plc reported on the results of their Annual General Meeting.

IGas Energy plc <u>published</u> an operations update, including the planning application for the Glentworth project to Lincolnshire County Council.

Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that ministers have refused a request to overturn planning permission for expansion and long-term production at West Newton-A.

South East

UK Oil & Gas plc published a white paper on the Portland Port hydrogen project.

Other news
