Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) plc <u>announced</u> that the North Sea Transition Authority had agreed an extension to their licence PEDL 343 which contains the Cloughton gas discovery.

<u>Union Jack Oil plc</u> and <u>Reabold Resources plc</u> announced a new proposal to drill a well at the West Newton-A site.
