## East Midlands

IGas Energy plc <u>announced</u> that it had completed its scheduled six-monthly Reserves Based Lending facility redetermination process. IGas <u>announced</u> the retirement of the Interim Non-executive Chairman and the appointment of a Non-executive Director.

Rathlin Energy Ltd have <u>submitted</u> a planning application to East Riding of Yorkshire Council to construct an extension to the existing West Newton A wellsite.

Union Jack Oil plc <u>announced</u> that US \$2,000,000 revenues had been generated by Wressle since production recommenced in August 2021. Union Jack <u>published</u> an update on the modelled flow rate analysis for West Newton.

Egdon Resources PLC <u>published</u> the results of Downhole Pressure Data Analysis for Wressle. Egdon Resources <u>announced</u> that they intend to submit an appeal against the refusal of planning permission by Lincolnshire County council for a side-track at Biscathorpe.

## South East

UK Oil & Gas PLC (UKOG) <u>announced</u> that the appeal for planning consent at Loxley will now be made by the Secretary of State for Levelling UP, Housing and Communities.

Angus Energy PLC <u>announced</u> that a strategic review and Formal Sale Process had been launched. Angus later <u>announced</u> that they had received at least six approaches. Angus later <u>published</u> a further update.

South Western Energy Limited (SWEL) have <u>submitted</u> new documents to Dorset Council for a drilling site near Puddletown.
