

Overview of conventional onshore UK Oil and Gas – July 2020

This is a summary overview of developments in the conventional onshore UK Oil and Gas industry. It includes planning, operations and business activities as well as objections and protests.

East Midlands

IGas <u>declared</u> a pre-tax loss of £59.1m for 2019 in their group annual results. IGas <u>announced</u> that they are issuing 750,000 shares to the AIM market to satisfy a salary sacrifice scheme. IGas <u>announced</u> that they are reviewing capital spending plans in light of the increase in oil price.

Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that Egdon Resources are applying to extend their planning consent for exploration at North Kelsey in Lincolnshire.

The Chairman of <u>Rathlin Energy</u>, David Montagu-Smith has stepped down from the Board. <u>Campaigners</u> have set up a camp to monitor operations at West Newton.

The government has <u>approved</u> Third Energy's plans to continue extracting gas in the Vale of Pickering. Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that North Yorkshire Council have also approved the plan. Reports on the legal challenge to the Oil & Gas Authority (OGA) on the takeover of Third Energy by York Energy, <u>day 1</u>, <u>day 2</u>.

Angus Energy <u>announced</u> that they have entered an agreement with National Grid to construct National Grid Facilities at Threddlethorpe. Angus Energy <u>announced</u> the repayment of £58,333 of their loan with Riverfort.

South East

Drill or Drop? <u>report</u> that Extinction Rebellion staged a protest at the Horse Hill wellsite owned by UK Oil & Gas PLC (UKOG). West Sussex County Council <u>agreed</u> to extend the planning permission for UKOG's Broadford Bridge site. A campaigner is to <u>challenge</u> the decision by Surrey County Council to approve UKOG's plans to drill more wells and extend production at Horse Hill.

Arreton Parish Council has <u>objected</u> to UKOG's plans to drill two exploration wells in the Isle of Wight. The <u>local MP</u> has also raised objections to the plans. The <u>Isle of Wight Green Party</u> is to host a call with experienced anti-fracking and drilling campaigners from Lancashire.

Union Jack Oil Director, Joseph O'Farrell, is <u>reported</u> to have purchased 11,100,000 ordinary shares in Union Jack Oil. Union Jack <u>announced</u> that the OGA had approved the acquisition of a further 3% interest in PEDL253 (Biscathorpe) from Montrose Industries Ltd.

Europa Oil & Gas <u>announced</u> that their Finance Director, Mr Phil Greenhalgh is to retire on 14 October 2020, they also announced changes to their Cost Management Programme.

Other news

MetalNRG <u>announced</u> that they are looking to acquire a portfolio of onshore, conventional Oil & Gas assets in the UK.

Scottish Labour are to bring forward a bill to ban fracking in Scotland.
