Angus Energy plc <u>announced</u> that remedial work on a compressor engine had been completed and that the Saltfleetby field had returned to normal operation. Angus Energy <u>published</u> an update on financing and that George Lucan the Executive chair would be stepping down in August.

Egdon Resources plc <u>announced</u> the transfer of ownership of licence PEDL343 from Egdon Resources U.K. Ltd to Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) plc.

South East

UK Oil & Gas PLC (UKOG) <u>announced</u> that the Avington Joint Operating Committee has agreed to restart production at the field. Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> on the High Court decision to allow work to proceed at Dunsfold.
