Fast Midlands

Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> on the High Court decision to refuse the permission for Heyco Energy, formerly Egdon Resources for production and further drilling at Biscathorpe in Lincolnshire.

Europa Oil & Gas Ltd has applied for <u>planning permission</u> from North Yorkshire Council to drill a well at Burniston, Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> on the application.

Angus Energy plc <u>published</u> their production and operations update for the second quarter of 2024. Angus Energy <u>reported</u> that they had successfully completed their planned annual maintenance shutdown at Saltfleetby. Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that Angus Energy has submitted plans for drilling and testing at two sites at the Saltfleetby field.
