East Midlands

IGas Energy PLC [published](#) an operational, reserves and financial update for the year ended 31 December 2021.

Lincolnshire County Council planners backed Egdon Resources [application](#) to extend planning permission for their site at North Kelsey. The application was [rejected](#) by the council at the planning meeting. Egdon Resources [announced](#) that they plan to appeal against the decision.

Drill or Drop [report](#) that East Riding of Yorkshire Council planners have recommended Rathlin Energy's planning application for West Newton-A for approval. Rathlin Energy [announced](#) that the planning committee had approved their application.

Angus Energy PLC [announced](#) that the Environmental Agency has issued its Variation Notice for the existing Saltfleetby gas field permit.

South East

Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) PLC [announced](#) that they planned to raise up to £7 million via a discounted placing and subscription in order to buy a farm in to UKCS block 13/23c.

The Environmental Agency have [issued](#) a permit variation to Angus Energy to re-inject waste water at their Brockham site.

UK Oil & Gas PLC (UKOG) [published](#) an update saying that the decision on their appeal against Surrey County Council's refusal of planning permission for their Loxley project is expected on or before 7 June 2022. UKOG [published](#) their Annual Review and Accounts for the year ended 30 September 2021.

Drill or Drop [report](#) that South Western Energy Limited have withdrawn their planning application for a site near Dorchester.

Other news
