East Midlands

Angus Energy plc [announced](#) the results of its General Meeting. Angus Energy [published](#) their Annual Report and accounts for the year ending 30 September 2023. Angus Energy [announced](#) the resignation of their Non-Executive Chairman Patrick Clanwilliam, he is replaced on an interim basis by Krzysztof Zielicki, currently a Non-Executive Director.

Drill or Drop? [reported](#) on a planning application for Wressle, including two new wells.

South East

UK Oil & Gas plc (UKOG) [published](#) the results of their reconvened General Meeting. West Sussex County Council (WSSC) planners published a [report](#) recommending extending planning permission for the Broadford Bridge site owned by UKOG. UKOG [published](#) an update on the Loxley Gas project.
