This is Money <u>reported</u> on an attempt by minority shareholders to overthrow the board of Reabold Resources. Energy Voice also <u>reported</u> on the story. Reabold Resources <u>published</u> a response to the Requisitioning Shareholders. At a special meeting the resolutions to replace the board of Reabold was <u>rejected</u>.

Egdon Resources published their preliminary results for the year ended 31 July 2022.

Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) plc <u>published</u> their final results for the year ended 31 July 2022. Europa <u>published</u> an update on the Inezgane offshore Morocco licence

Angus Energy plc <u>published</u> an update on the progress of their Saltfleetby sidetrack.
