

## Overview of conventional onshore UK Oil and Gas – October 2020

This is a summary overview of developments in the conventional onshore UK Oil and Gas industry. It includes planning, operations and business activities as well as objections and protests.

## East Midlands

Rathlin Energy Ltd <u>announced</u> that drilling has started at their West Newton B site. Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> on details for the proposed West Newton C and D exploration sites.

Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that the case challenging the decommissioning costs for Third Energy's wells in Yorkshire has been dismissed by the court. Drill or Drop? <u>published</u> extracts from an interview with Russell Hoare, the managing director of Third Energy.

Angus Energy PLC <u>announced</u> that work was to commence on the pipeline at Saltfleetby.

Europa Oil & Gas plc, <u>published</u> their final results for the year ending 31 July 2020.

Union Jack Oil PLC <u>announced</u> that they will acquire an additional 30% interest in PEDL241, which contains the proposed North Kelsey well.

## South East

UK Oil & Gas PLC (UKOG) <u>announced</u> that following the arrival of a small workover rig, routine intervention operations were to start on their Horse Hill-1 well. Horse Hill Developments Ltd <u>published</u> their financial statements for year ending 30 September 2019, showing a loss of £1,155,205. Surrey County Council (SCC) <u>approved</u> UKOG's Transport and Traffic Management Plan for Horse Hill. Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that the meeting by SCC to consider UKOG's plans to drill at Dunsfold has been postponed until 27 November. Extinction Rebellion protestors <u>occupied</u> the Horse Hill wellsite. Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that UKOG have made changes to the proposed access route for Arreton in the Isle of Wight. UKOG <u>announced</u> that they have relinquished PEDL143, which contained the proposed Leith Hill site.

A <u>presentation</u> from Angus Energy to investors said that they intend to restart oil production at Brockham, subject to approvals by the Environmental Agency and Oil & Gas Authority. Angus <u>announced</u> that they had executed a Sale & Purchase Agreement for the purchase of Doriemus plc's 10% interest in the Brockham licence PL235. Drill or Drop? <u>reported</u> that the Oil & Gas Authority have agreed to extend the licence for PL235 for 6 months.

A <u>report</u> by the Weald Action Group refutes claims that UK onshore oil has a lower carbon footprint than imported oil. (Link will download report).

IGas <u>announced</u> that it had signed a memorandum of understanding with BayoTech, to produce hydrogen from natural gas.



## Other news

UKOG <u>announced</u> that it had successfully raised £2.2 million to fund its share of initial drilling and seismic cost for the Turkish Resan project.
