East Midlands

Egdon Resources plc <u>announced</u> that they had executed a fully termed agreement to enable a farm-in and equalisation of interests between PL81 and PEDL347 with York Energy and Cuadrilla Resources. Egdon Resources <u>announced</u> that the takeover by Petrichor Partners LP had become effective.

Europa Oil & Gas (Holdings) plc <u>published</u> an update on Gas in Place at Cloughton.

Union Jack Oil plc <u>published</u> their unaudited results for the six months ended 30 June 2023. Union Jack Oil <u>announced</u> that they had acquired a 3% shareholding in Beacon Energy's subsidiary Rhein Petroleum GmbH. Union Jack <u>published</u> an update on West Newton, the Environment Agency has now allowed the use of oil-based fluids within the Permian formations during drilling and testing operations.

Star Energy Group plc published their unaudited interim results for the six months to 30 June 2023.

Rathlin Energy (UK) <u>published</u> (27 September 2023) their Directors' Report and Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2022.
